Upon inspecting the machine, the inspectors found counters set at zero, and the voting machines in proper condition for use. Inspector Darlene Howland declared the polls officially open at 12:00 p.m., and Lila Hall cast the first ballot as a final machine check.

A poll list, consisting of 239 names and 13 absentee ballots, for a total of 252 names, is attached to the minute book. The machine votes totaled 239 plus 13 absentee ballot votes for a total of 252 votes.

All qualified persons within the voting place at the time polls were closed had voted. The last vote was cast by George Bladdick and the machine was sealed at 9:01 p.m. The absentee ballots were then opened by the clerk/inspectors and the votes tallied.
