

BOARD OF EDUCATION, SPECIAL MEETING
Tuesday, May 12, 2020

CALL TO ORDER:

A special meeting of the Board of Education was held remotely via Google Meet and was called to order by President Raymond Parmarter at 6:03 p.m., with the following additional board members present: Nate Brace, Josh Soper, Rebecca Lyon, Brent Doane, Hannah Murray, and Michael Blake. Also present was Superintendent Jeffrey Kisloski, Board Clerk Kathlyn Hinkle, Sydney Wade, Wayne Aman, Peter Ahart, Angela Holmes, Kimberleigh Nichols, and Katie Volpicelli. There were no visitors present.

The Pledge of Allegiance was said to begin the meeting.

ACCEPTANCE OF STATEMENT OF EXPENDITURES:

Upon the recommendation of Superintendent Kisloski, the Board accepted the 2020-2021 Statement of Expenditures with the following resolution:

“RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Candor Central School District, be and hereby is authorized to expend for school purposes, the sums set forth in the proposed 2020-2021 Statement of Estimated Expenditures, in the amount of \$18,880,726, and to levy the necessary tax on the taxable property of said District.”

The proposed budget for 2020-2021 will result in a 1.94% tax levy increase.

A roll call vote was taken: Ayes - 6 (Brace, Soper, Parmarter, Lyon, Doane, and Blake)
Nays - 1 (Murray)

The motion carried 6 ayes and 1 nay.

President Parmarter declared the meeting adjourned at 6:39 p.m.
