Inspectors Ed Roberts, Darlene Howland, and Joanne Worden were present at 12:00 p.m. with Assistant Clerks Kathlyn Hinkle and Amy Shepardson. Upon inspecting the machine, Inspector Darlene Howland found counters set at zero, and the voting machine in proper condition for use. Inspector Darlene Howland declared the polls officially open at 12:00 p.m., and Ed Roberts cast the first ballot as a final machine check. (Machine # NYNAGCL0109; Opening Protective Counter #3426; Closing #3443 AND Machine # NYJAC8N4688; Opening Protective Counter #4661; Closing #4839).

A poll list, consisting of 196 names and 11 absentee ballots, for a total of 207 names, is attached to the minute book. The machine votes totaled 195 plus 11 absentee ballot votes for a total of 206 votes. (difference due to spoiled ballot)

All qualified persons within the voting place at the time polls were closed had voted. The last vote was cast by Michael Swartz and the machine was sealed at 9:00 p.m. The absentee ballots were then opened by the clerk/inspectors and the votes tallied. Inspector Cindy Swartz announced the following results:
